6th and 7th Grade

8th graders at St. John's study topics related to the sacramental rite of Confirmation. Youth may or may not choose to be confirmed.

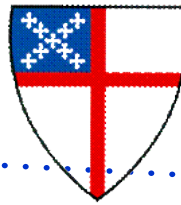
This curriculum was developed and written by St. John's staff, clergy and teacher!
